Start analysing George Orwell's 'Animal Farm.' Read Chapters 1-5 and annotate copy. Specimen exams questions to be attempted.</p>
Autumn 2 (Nov-Dec) Paper 2	<p>Paper 2: finish analysing George Orwell's 'Animal Farm.'</p> <p><u>Link with the OCR History depth study 'Living Under Nazi Rule 1933-1945:' Totalitarianism versus Communism and the contentious relationship between Hitler and Stalin that culminated in the German-Soviet Pact of August 1939.</u></p>
Spring 1 (Jan-Feb) Paper 2	<p>Paper 2: Start analysing and developing the skills to explore Unseen Poetry to prepare for Section C of Paper 2.</p>
Spring 2 (Mar-Apr) Paper 1	<p>Paper 1 and Paper 2: revise both papers and return to revise 'Macbeth' and 'The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr Hyde' for Paper 1.</p>
Summer 1 (Apr – May) Paper 2	<p>Paper 1 and Paper 2: revise both papers and return to 'Macbeth' and 'The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr Hyde.'</p>
